# Devotional: Facing Excuses: Breaking Free from Laziness

- Philippians 2:3-4 "Do nothing out of selfish ambition but in humility value others above yourselves."
- Matthew 23:11 "The greatest among you will be your servant."







## Devotional: Humility Transforms Work into Worship
