Day 1: 🥬 The Foundation of True Wisdom

Devotional: Ask God First for Wisdom in Every Situation

Wisdom begins with God.

When confronting legal matters, it is easy to rely on human reasoning alone and risk compromising convictions. But God's wisdom guides us beyond this limitation, teaching us how to act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly (Micah 6:8). We ask God for wisdom to discern the best path—when to assert our rights and when to prioritize spiritual virtue.

Devotional: Use Your Rights to Uphold, Not Undermine, Your Faith

Paul's Roman citizenship gave him legal rights few Jews had.

This example teaches us that God can provide legal protections, not as a shield to forsake faith but as a platform to advance it. Paul used his rights wisely—asserting them respectfully and strategically without losing sight of his calling.

Today, consider how you might follow Paul's example: recognize your legal rights wisely, use them respectfully, and trust God to glorify His name through your testimony. Legal protections are resources to support your faith, not replace it.

Devotional: Stand Firm in Faith When Facing Legal Pressure

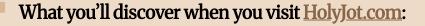




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
