- Hebrews 12:15 "See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up."
- Colossians 3:13 "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance."







### Devotional: Choosing Forgiveness Over Bitterness

Land and property disputes can leave deep wounds that tempt us toward bitterness. However, Scripture warns against holding onto anger, slander, or resentment, which only poison relationships and block God's healing.
