Day 2: W Submission Without Compromise

This day reminds us to live peacefully within society while prayerfully discerning boundaries. Submission honors God by showing respect for His ordained structures, but it also calls us to live boldly in integrity.

Devotional: Obey God First in Conflicts

The apostles' bold declaration to obey God over men is a foundational example for believers. When human laws force us to sin or deny Christ, we must stand firm, even at great personal cost.

Faithful obedience doesn't mean rebellion but honors God's higher authority. Daniel's friends and the Hebrew midwives risked death rather than compromise their convictions. Their courage was anchored in trust that God is ultimately sovereign over rulers.

If you face laws or rules that contradict God's commands, seek His strength to respond faithfully. Remember that standing firm honors God and can inspire others toward truth.
