#### Introduction

Day 1: **B** The Beginning of Wisdom

#### Devotional: Start Your Journey with Reverence

Wisdom begins with reverence for God. The biblical phrase "fear of the LORD" is not about terror but about awe, respect, and recognition of God's supreme authority. When we understand God's holiness and love, we begin to see life from His perspective.

Today, take time to enter quietly into God's presence. Acknowledge Him as the source of all wisdom and seek His guidance. Meditation on this truth opens your mind to spiritual understanding and guards your heart from empty pursuits.

Delighting in God's law means to find joy and satisfaction in His guidance. This joy transforms meditation from a routine into a rich encounter. #### Devotional: Embrace Wisdom by Listening More

Wisdom often begins with silence. Proverbs warns against answering prematurely, highlighting the value of listening before speaking. Wise living involves cultivating the habit of pausing, hearing others fully, and seeking understanding rather than rushing to respond.

In your quiet time today, reflect on your listening habits. Are you patient and attentive, or quick to reply? Meditation on God's wisdom invites us to slow down, weigh our words carefully, and embody humility.

Ask God to help you control your tongue and communicate with kindness, reflecting His love in every conversation. Wise speech nurtures relationships and reflects a heart aligned with God's wisdom.
