Genesis 37:23-28 "So when Joseph came to his brothers, they stripped him of his robe... and sold him to the Ishmaelites for twenty shekels of silver."

Devotional: Trusting God in Unexpected Trials

Joseph's story starts with betrayal and injustice. His brothers, consumed by jealousy, sold him into slavery. Imagine the shock and pain Joseph must have felt. Yet, even in this dark moment, God's plan was unfolding. Joseph didn't lose sight of God's presence despite circumstances beyond his control.

Devotional: God's Presence Brings Wisdom in Darkness

In prison, Joseph found favor not by his own power but through God's presence with him. Even behind bars, God's wisdom allowed Joseph to stand out as responsible and trustworthy.

True wisdom often manifests in how we handle situations when we feel powerless. Joseph didn't waste energy on despair. Instead, he used what little influence he had to serve with excellence. This teaches us that wisdom is practical: it influences how we live daily, no matter the environment.

God's steadfast love empowers us to shine in dark places. Where are you feeling imprisoned by circumstances? Pray for God's presence to be near and for wisdom to act rightly. God can transform the restrictions in your life into opportunities for growth and blessing.

2. How can I demonstrate wisdom and faithfulness where I currently am?

3. Do I trust that God's presence can change my situation or perspective?

2. List ways you can be faithful and wise even in challenging environments.

3. Pray for increasing trust that God works in your trials.

Day 3: 💡 Interpreting Dreams with Wisdom

Devotional: Humility in Divine Discernment

Joseph's God-given ability to interpret dreams highlighted a special gift of **wisdom and discernment**. But notice his humility: he attributes the interpretations solely to God's power.

Wisdom includes recognizing when we need divine insight beyond human understanding. It is humility to acknowledge that our wisdom is limited and to seek God's revelation regularly.

We may not interpret dreams literally, but God speaks in various ways. The question is, are we listening and trusting Him accurately? It's a reminder to seek God's guidance in all decisions, big or small.

Devotional: Forgiveness: The Mark of Wise Leadership
