#### Devotional: Choosing God's Wisdom Amid Pressure

Day 3: V Standing Firm with Courageous Wisdom

#### Devotional: Courageous Wisdom to Stand Unshaken

Courage fuels wisdom when standing against societal pressures. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refused to comply with a king's idolatrous command despite the threat of death. Their faith and courage embodied wisdom—they trusted God's power but accepted His will even if deliverance did not come.

Wisdom isn't just about careful thought or strategy; it's deeply connected to the heart's faithfulness and courage. Standing firm in a hostile culture requires boldness grounded in the assurance of God's sovereignty.

Reflect on your own challenges—what would it look like to say, "Even if God does not rescue me, I will not compromise"? Your courageous wisdom is formed as you choose faith above fear.

#### Devotional: Humility: The Heart of True Wisdom

Humility is essential to true wisdom. King Nebuchadnezzar learned this firsthand through God's discipline, recognizing that all dominion and power come from God alone. Daniel's humility and faith reflected a heart that acknowledged God's greatness above all.

Living wisely means surrendering pride and self-reliance and embracing a posture of dependence on God. Humble faith opens doors to receive grace, correction, and greater wisdom from the Lord.

Reflect on your attitude. Are you walking humbly with God, or clinging to your own strength? Wisdom flourishes when rooted in humility and reverence for God's supremacy.
