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#### Introduction

Each day includes Scripture to meditate on, reflections to challenge your heart, and prayers to enable your spirit. By the end of this study, you will be equipped to **discern laws that violate God's Word**, respond biblically, and maintain peace in your conscience, knowing you obey the true King.

#### Your Verse

#### Devotional: Begin with Reverence for God

Wisdom starts with a holy reverence for God. Proverbs 9:10 reminds us that knowing God is the foundation upon which all true wisdom is built. Without this beginning, no matter how much human knowledge we acquire, we remain spiritually short-sighted and vulnerable to deception.

When discerning laws or policies that contradict Scripture, this foundational reverence shapes every step. It reminds us that God's authority supersedes human authority. It teaches us to seek His perspective first and rely on His guidance through prayer and study.

Ask yourself today: Where does your wisdom come from? Are you seeking God's understanding above all else? This day invites you to humble yourself before the Lord, asking Him to open your eyes to His truth and give you wisdom to stand firm regardless of earthly pressures.

#### Your Verse

Acts 5:29 – "Peter and the other apostles replied: 'We must obey God rather than human beings!'"

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Romans 13:1 "Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established."
- Daniel 3:16-18 "Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego replied... Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us... but if not, we will not serve your gods."







Day 2: 💯 Understanding God's Higher Law

#### Devotional: God's Authority Above All

Obedience to God's law takes precedence over human laws. While Romans encourages respect for governing authorities, the Bible also clearly shows that when earthly laws contradict God's commands, Christians must obey God first.

Acts 5:29 highlights the apostles' bold declaration when commanded to stop preaching the Gospel. They chose to obey God regardless of human punishment. Similarly, Daniel's friends faced fiery consequences yet refused to bow to unjust laws.

What legal or cultural pressures might challenge your faith or Biblical convictions today? This day challenges you to reflect on the supremacy of God's law and to prepare your heart to stand firm, even under threat. Remember, God honors those who honor Him and grants strength to those who trust Him steadfastly in these moments.

- Proverbs 3:21–22 "My son, do not let wisdom and understanding out of your sight... They will be life for your soul."







#### Devotional: Cultivating Spiritual Discernment

Godly wisdom enables believers to discern truth from lies. In a world full of competing ideas and laws, spiritual discernment is essential to identify what aligns with God's Word and what does not. 1 John 4:1 warns us to test what we hear and see with the filter of Scripture.

Discernment is a skill that grows through constant study and obedience. Hebrews 5:14 reminds us that maturity comes by practicing this skill diligently, helping us avoid deception and stand on solid ground.

Today, ask the Lord to sharpen your spiritual senses and to protect your heart and mind from misleading teachings and laws. Wisdom is not automatic; it is cultivated by abiding in God and living in obedience to His commands. This grants you the clarity to navigate legal and societal complexities faithfully.

#### Your Verse

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Joshua 1:9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged..."
- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."







Day 4: ① Courage to Stand Firm

#### Devotional: God's Armor Empowers Courage

Standing against unjust laws requires strength and courage rooted in God's power. The call to stand firm—no matter the cost—is punctuated in Ephesians 6, where Paul urges believers to take up the full armor of God. This armor spiritually equips us to withstand pressure, intimidation, and opposition.

Joshua's command to be strong and courageous encourages us that courage is not optional for discipleship. God's Spirit empowers us with power and love, overpowering fear and timidity.

When the legal system contradicts God's commands, do not retreat in fear but stand boldly, trusting in God's provision and protection. Pray fervently for God to embolden your heart and fill you with His peace in times of trial.

- Proverbs 15:1 "A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger."







#### Devotional: Wise and Gentle Responses

Wisdom includes knowing how to respond tactfully and effectively. Jesus instructed His followers to be both innocent and shrewd as they face hostility, balancing discernment with purity of heart. This is vital when dealing with opposing laws or systems.

Colossians 4:5 calls us to wise conduct—making the best use of opportunities to bear witness. Proverbs reminds us that even our words can influence outcomes, pointing us towards gentleness rather than harshness.

Consider how you can respond with both boldness and grace. Sometimes standing firm means speaking out, other times it means patiently persevering with a gentle spirit. Pray today for wisdom to navigate these balances and for God to guide your steps in peaceful, intentional action.

Are there situations where gentle patience is wiser than confrontation?

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 46:1-2 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."







Day 6: A Trusting God's Sovereignty

#### Devotional: Resting in God's Control

**Even when legal systems or circumstances feel oppressive, God remains sovereign and at work.** Romans 8:28 reassures us that God can bring good from every situation for those who love Him.

Isaiah reminds us that God's plans surpass our understanding, and Psalm 46 encourages us to take refuge in His presence and power amid any trouble.

When standing firm for God's truth leads to hardship, trust deeply that He controls the outcome. Your obedience aligns with His greater purposes, even when invisible at the moment. Today, reflect on God's sovereignty and rest in His eternal care, knowing He never forsakes His children.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Philippians 2:15 "...so that you may become blameless and pure, 'children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation."
- Matthew 5:16 "Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."







#### Devotional: Wisdom That Glorifies God

True wisdom results in a transformed life that pleases God and influences the world around us. Colossians calls believers to live worthily—with integrity and steadfastness—bearing fruit even in difficult environments.

Philippians reminds us that godly living stands out visibly in a flawed world, and Jesus teaches that our good deeds should draw others to glorify God.

As you conclude this study, commit to living with godly wisdom in every area —especially when confronted with laws or ideas that oppose Scripture. Let your life be a shining testimony of God's wisdom, grace, and truth.
