#### Devotional: Redeeming Time with God's Purpose

**Time is one of our most valuable assets**—an unrenewable gift from God. The apostle Paul urges believers to walk wisely and make the most of every opportunity, recognizing the brevity and challenges of life. Wise investment of time means prioritizing what truly honors God and advances His kingdom rather than succumbing to distractions and busyness.

Psalm 90 reminds us to "number our days"—to live with intentionality and perspective. How often do we pause to evaluate whether our daily routines, commitments, and activities reflect this wisdom? By stewarding our time wisely, we align ourselves with God's purpose and demonstrate accountability as His servants.

Take a moment to identify time-wasters or habits that do not glorify God. Ask, "Am I using this hour to invest in people, growth, or service?" Rather than passive consumption or meaningless busyness, wise stewardship of time requires focused effort, prayerful planning, and sometimes, saying "no" to good things for the best things.

Today, commit to making wise choices about your daily schedule, seeking God's guidance to redeem each moment for eternal significance.

- Matthew 25:14–16 (Parable of the Talents) "The one who had received the five talents went at once and put his money to work..."







Day 2: O Using Talents for God's Glory

#### Devotional: Faithful Stewardship of God's Gifts

God has uniquely equipped each believer with talents and gifts to serve His kingdom purposes. These gifts are not just for personal benefit, but to bless others and to be faithful stewards of His grace. Peter encourages us to use what we have received well, remembering that each gift carries responsibility.

The Parable of the Talents teaches that God expects action and growth with what He entrusts. The servant who invested his talents was praised, while the one who hid his was rebuked. Similarly, God desires that we recognize our abilities and step out in faith to multiply their impact.

Reflect on your talents—whether natural skills, spiritual gifts, or learned abilities. Are you actively using them to serve others? Sometimes fear, complacency, or comparison can keep us from fully embracing our gifts. God calls you to faithful stewardship, offering your talents as an offering of love and obedience.

Today, commit to identifying one talent God gave you and find a way to use it intentionally for His glory and the good of others.

- Matthew 6:19–21 "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth...
  But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven..."







#### Devotional: Honoring God Through Generous Giving

Our material riches are gifts from God to be managed wisely. Proverbs reminds us to honor Him with our wealth, giving our best and first—acknowledging God's ownership of all we possess. Generosity is a wise investment that yields spiritual and sometimes even earthly blessings.

Paul encourages cheerful giving, emphasizing that God values the heart behind the gift more than the amount. Stewardship of treasure involves intentional budgeting, giving, and resisting the temptation to hoard wealth selfishly.

Jesus teaches that where our treasure is, our hearts will be also—inviting us to invest in eternal treasure. Wise stewardship means aligning our finances with God's kingdom rather than fleeting worldly gains. Reflect on how you allocate your resources—are they advancing God's purposes?

Commit today to honor God in your finances, giving generously, and trusting Him as the ultimate provider.
