Devotional: Rooted in Your Unique Purpose

Feeling pulled in many directions? It's natural for women juggling ministry, marriage, and motherhood to sometimes question their worth and calling. Yet, Psalm 139 reminds us *God created each of us intentionally and beautifully.* You are not an accident; you are His masterpiece designed for unique purposes—both in your family and His Kingdom.

- Matthew 6:33 'But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.'







Devotional: Serving Christ First in Ministry

Ministry is a vital calling, but it's easy to get overwhelmed or distracted by the many demands. Colossians 3 reminds us our work is ultimately done for Christ, not humans. When we place Him first, ministry becomes a joyful act of worship rather than a burdensome obligation.

Juggling ministry alongside marriage and motherhood means learning to say "no" sometimes or setting healthy boundaries with grace. Trusting that God values quality over quantity allows room for rest and reflection.

Remember: Christ invites you to lean on Him every step—letting His strength empower and His love motivate your service.

Pray for wisdom in prioritizing tasks, asking God to align your ministry efforts with His purposes instead of worldly expectations.

Devotional: Christ-Centered Marriage Strengthens You Both

Marriage is a sacred partnership designed by God to reflect His love. But juggling ministry and motherhood often leaves relationships strained or neglected. Ephesians 5 calls husbands and wives to love sacrificially—modeled on Christ's love for His church.

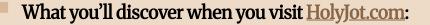
