Day 2: (Courageous Leadership in God's Timing

Devotional: Leading Boldly in God's Strength

Deborah stands as a shining example of courageous leadership among women in the Bible. She led with wisdom, faith, and boldness at a time when Israel desperately needed guidance. Her story invites us to step into the roles God calls us to, even when it feels daunting or unconventional.

There may be seasons when God places you in leadership — of your family, community, or church — with a specific purpose to disciple others. Like Deborah, the courage to lead comes from knowing God is with you.

Sharing your story as a woman of faith means embracing the roles God has entrusted you with and stepping out in confidence. Your testimony of overcoming fear or self-doubt by relying on God can inspire younger women to trust Him with their own callings.

Devotional: Faith in Prayer Sustains the Soul

When discipling younger women, your testimony of God's faithfulness in prayer encourages them to be persistent and hopeful, even when answers seem delayed. Prayer becomes a key tool in spiritual growth and connection.

Sharing how God has responded to your prayers, big or small, demonstrates His loving attention to personal needs. It reminds younger women that their prayers matter and that God is trustworthy through every season.

Devotional: Empowering Younger Women Through Godly Wisdom

The Bible clearly highlights the vital role older women play in mentoring younger generations. Titus 2 commands older women to teach and inspire younger ones, using the wisdom earned through life experiences.

Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:2-4 "Consider it pure joy... whenever you face trials of many kinds."
- Romans 5:3–5 "Suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope."







Devotional: God Comforts Us to Comfort Others

Our challenges are often the most powerful parts of our testimony. The Apostle Paul reminds us that God comforts us in our trials so that we, in turn, can comfort others going through similar struggles.

When discipling younger women, your story of God's faithfulness in hardship reassures them that faith can be sustained even in the darkest times. You model how hope is born through perseverance.

Sharing both struggles and victories breaks down barriers and builds authentic community. It shows younger women that they are not alone and that God's love is constant.

Reflect today on how your trials have brought growth and how your testimony can become a source of comfort and hope.
