Day 1: **B** Trusting God in the Waiting

Devotional: Hope Grows Strong in Silent Prayer

Hannah's story is one of heartfelt prayer in a season of deep longing. She prayed fervently for a child, yet her prayers initially seemed unanswered. In her silence, she didn't turn away from God; instead, she poured out her soul with hope and trust. Devotional: Joy Comes After Seasons of Waiting

Your Verse

Luke 1:38 - "I am the Lord's servant...May your word to me be fulfilled."

Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 12:1 "Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God."
- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the LORD with all your heart."







Day 4: 3 Mary's Submission to God's Plan

Devotional: Faithful Surrender Builds Trust in God

Mary's response to God's call shows deep trust and willingness to surrender her plans. Though uncertain and facing hardship, she submitted fully, trusting God's purposes.

Sometimes unanswered prayers teach us surrender and obedience. Like Mary, we can choose faith over fear and say, "Your will be done." Trust grows when we release control and lean fully on God's plans, knowing He is good and sovereign.

- Psalm 27:14 "Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD."
- James 1:12 "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial."







Devotional: Persevering in Worship Sustains Hope

Anna's faithfulness during a long wait teaches perseverance and continual worship. Even though she waited for many years, she remained devoted to God, demonstrating that worship is not dependent on answers but on God Himself.

When prayers go unanswered, worship and devotion can sustain our hearts and keep our faith alive. Anna's example encourages us not to give up but to remain diligent and joyful in our relationship with God, trusting that He will fulfill His promises.

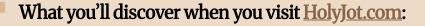
