Devotional: Embracing God's Peace Amid Fear

Prayer for Today

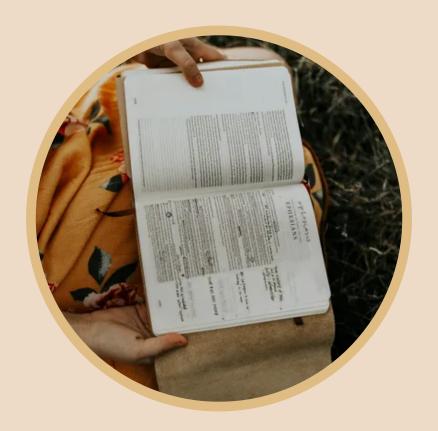

Devotional: Finding Divine Strength in Weakness

Prayer for Today

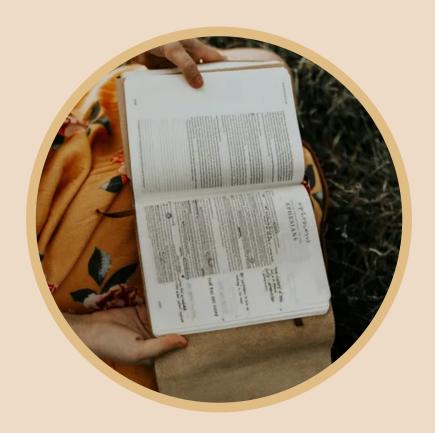
