Devotional: Foundations of Unfailing Love and Hope

Love rooted in God's faithfulness transforms letters into treasures. As you prepare to write, reflect today on the unchanging love of the Lord—steady, compassionate, and renewing each morning. This kind of love will be the foundation of your message.

Your grandchild needs to understand that God's love is not based on circumstances or perfection but on His eternal nature. Through trials and triumphs, His faithfulness remains.
