As you engage in this study, allow God's Word to equip you with grace for your spouse, guidance for your journey, and joy in the hope that love grounded in Christ is never in vain. Devotional: Love: Patient, Kind, and Enduring Always

Love is the foundation for supporting your spouse through struggles in faith. *Patience* and kindness are not always easy when doubts or distancing arise, yet they are essential. The apostle Paul reminds us that love is enduring—even when the journey is tough and the outcome uncertain.

Rather than responding in frustration or discouragement, choose to show grace. This isn't passive acceptance but an active, compassionate love that seeks to understand and uplift. Your *quiet endurance* in love creates space for your spouse to wrestle with doubts safely, knowing they are not alone.

Let God's love flow through you as a healing balm in moments of tension. When you embody patience, humility, and kindness, your marriage becomes an oasis of grace. This love reflects Christ himself, who meets us all in our broken places.

Day 2: ① Standing Firm in Truth with Love

Devotional: Firm Faith Guided by Love and Truth

Supporting a spouse struggling with faith does not mean compromising your beliefs. **Standing firm in truth** is essential. The Apostle Paul describes putting on the full armor of God, starting with the belt of truth, symbolizing your core commitment to God's Word.

However, standing firm does not mean being harsh or inflexible. True strength is characterized by *power*, *love*, *and self-discipline*. Your confidence in Christ provides a solid foundation from which you can lovingly but clearly share truth without judgment.

When confronted with doubts or questions, respond with grace and patience but remain anchored in God's promises. Let your life be a consistent testimony, showing that faith in Christ is both sincere and joyful. This balance between truth and love creates a safe environment where faith can grow or be rediscovered.

Devotional: God's Promises Bring Joy and Peace

Share verses that speak to God's presence in hardship, His unchanging love, and the joy that comes from trusting Him. These truths can light a path forward when the future seems uncertain.

Your gentle encouragement, coupled with God's promises, plants seeds that may grow into renewed faith. Never underestimate the power of Scripture spoken in love to bring comfort and strength.
