Devotional: Let Scripture Illuminate Your Dreams

The apostle Paul reminds Timothy that all Scripture is inspired by God and useful for guiding how we live and understand spiritual matters. In your dreams about the End Times, seek to measure what you experience against Scripture's teachings.

Using the Bible as your foundation will prevent confusion, false hope, or fear based on incomplete or misleading impressions. Let Scripture be a lamp, shedding light on your path, helping you distinguish between divine truth and personal imagination.

Today, read your favorite passage about Christ's return or God's promises and ask how your dreams align with it.

Devotional: Wisdom to Test Every Dream

Not all dreams come from God; some may be influenced by fear, spiritual deception, or even our own imagination. Scripture commands us to "test the spirits" to discern truth from error. This means evaluating your dreams carefully, prayerfully, and biblically.

Jesus warned that in the last days, many false prophets and messiahs will arise, producing counterfeit signs. To guard against deception, follow the example of the Berean Jews, who checked teachings against Scripture daily.

As you journal your End Times dreams, ask God to reveal any false elements and give you wisdom to reject what is not from Him. Trust that the Holy Spirit will help you separate genuine revelation from confusion or lies.

Remember, discernment is an ongoing practice of faith and humility.


