Devotional: Recognizing God's Guidance in Life

Every story begins with recognizing God's presence. Your life isn't random; it's authored by the One who has a plan for your hope and future (Jeremiah 29:11). Sometimes the path is clear, other times it's clouded with hardship or doubt. Yet, like Paul reminds us, God works all things together for your good according to His purpose (Romans 8:28).

Writing your testimony starts with recalling moments where you sense God's hand at work. These moments can be obvious like a clear answer to prayer, or subtle like unexpected peace during trials. Remembering these helps you see your life as a tapestry woven by divine purpose.

Take time today to reflect on significant events—both struggles and victories—and how God's faithfulness was evident. This is the foundation of your legacy.

- Isaiah 1:18 Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow.

Devotional: Embracing New Life in Christ

Your testimony is a story of transformation. When God redeems us, He offers grace that washes away our past and makes us new creations (2 Corinthians 5:17). This radical change is at the heart of every powerful testimony.

It's important to openly acknowledge our imperfections and sins, not out of shame, but as evidence of God's amazing grace. Isaiah reminds us that though our sins are scarlet, God can make us as white as snow.

Sharing how God broke into your life through forgiveness and renewal will inspire others to seek the same freedom. Reflect on the difference Christ has made in your heart and how grace continues to shape you.

Your Verse

Psalm 78:4 - We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord.

Supporting Scriptures

- Joshua 4:6 Tell your children about it, so they in turn will tell their children.
- 2 Timothy 1:5 I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also.







Day 3: figure Biblical Examples of Legacy

Devotional: Learning from the Faithful Men Before You

Your legacy continues a story told over generations. Scripture commands us to share God's deeds and faithfulness across the ages. The psalmist urges telling the next generation what God has done (Psalm 78:4), and Joshua reminds Israel to teach their children (Joshua 4:6).

Paul commends Timothy's faith, emphasizing the impact of those before him. This shows the value of passing on not just stories, but faith and character.

Reflect on the men who influenced your life and consider how you can intentionally pass on God's truths to those who come after you. Your testimony is not only your story—it's a link in an eternal chain of faith.

- Colossians 4:6 Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt.







Day 4: 🖄 Writing with Purpose and Clarity

Devotional: Crafting a Testimony That Speaks Clearly

Writing your testimony requires intentionality and prayer. Proverbs reminds us to commit our plans to the Lord, trusting Him to guide our words and message.

Habakkuk instructs writing clearly so the message can reach others effectively. When writing your story, clarity and purpose help your testimony resonate and inspire.

Furthermore, Paul's counsel to let conversations be full of grace reminds us to speak truth with kindness, inviting openness rather than judgment.

Pray as you write. Seek the Holy Spirit's guidance to highlight what God wants others to hear most through your story.

Supporting Scriptures

- Joshua 1:9 Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.
- Matthew 5:14 You are the light of the world.







Devotional: Facing Fear and Finding Courage

Fear and doubt can hinder sharing your testimony. But God has equipped you with power, love, and self-discipline to overcome timidity (2 Timothy 1:7).

Just as Joshua was commanded to be strong and courageous (Joshua 1:9), you are called to take your rightful place as a shining light (Matthew 5:14) through your story.

Take heart that vulnerability in sharing your journey is a strength, not a weakness. Your honesty can break chains and help others find freedom and faith.

Supporting Scriptures

- Colossians 4:5–6 Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity.
- Acts 1:8 You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses.







Devotional: Preparing to Speak with Impact

Sharing your testimony isn't just about telling a story—it's about communicating hope. Peter encourages us to be ready to explain what gives us hope, doing so with gentleness and respect.

The Apostle Paul further advises wisdom and making the most of every opportunity, understanding your audience and letting grace shape your words.

Pray for the Holy Spirit's power to be your guide and strength as you witness. Be intentional about when and how you share your testimony so it resonates and honors Christ.

- Hebrews 13:7 Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you.







Devotional: Legacy That Honors God Forever

As you conclude this study, remember your testimony is part of a greater story. Psalm 145 celebrates generations sharing God's mighty acts. Your story is a vital link in that chain.

Deuteronomy reminds us to teach God's truths diligently to our children—your life's testimony is an essential spiritual inheritance.
